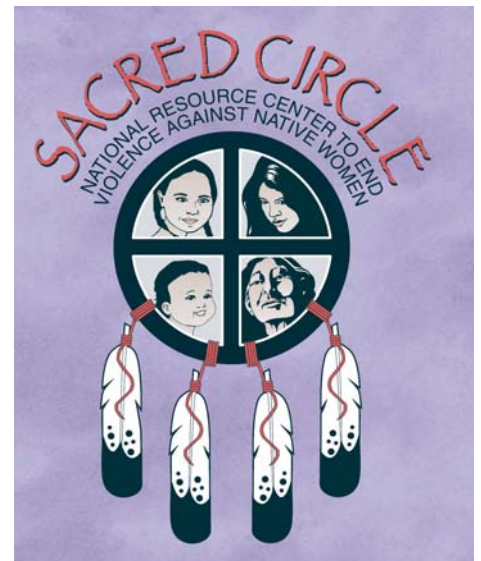

Description

Children exposed to domestic violence often experience psychological emotional and behavioral problems. Not able to heal from their experiences, co-occurring family violence, anxiety disorders, clinical depression and a variety of addictive disorders can become an "abnormal normalcy" in the family fabric of their adult lives. This workshop will be in an informal interactive format and not your typical classroom style. Participants will be asked to relate experiences in their own community. We will address the many related issues such as; how do we identify local, national resources and networking strategies? How to organize a coordinated community response to this legacy of violence in native families?

Wounded Spirits; The Legacy of Domestic Violence as Seen Through the Eyes of a Child will explore a number of issues in some detail along with developing intervention strategies to be employed at the community level.

Topics include:

- * Children observing violent behavior with an indepth look at its effect on emotional growth and development.
- * Family anger and how it gets passed on to future generations.
- * When Children become the emotional support for the abused parent (role reversal). The implications for adult caretaker relationships.
- * Connections of co-occurrence of drug & alcohol abuse and domestic violence and its debilitating lethal combination in a child's life.
- * Trauma associated with domestic violence is a life long legacy.
- * Networking strategies and model programs that can be applied at the local community level.
